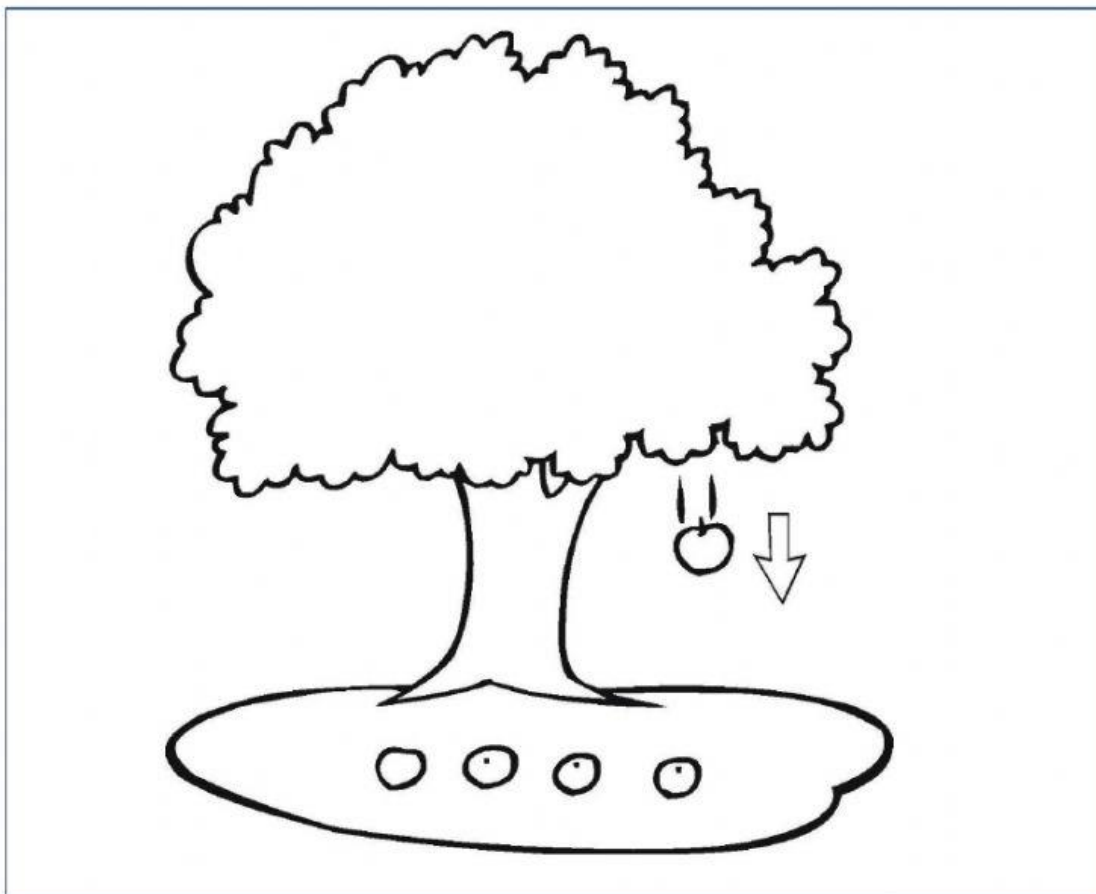
Drag **5** apples onto the tree



How many apples are shown on the ground? 2 4 6

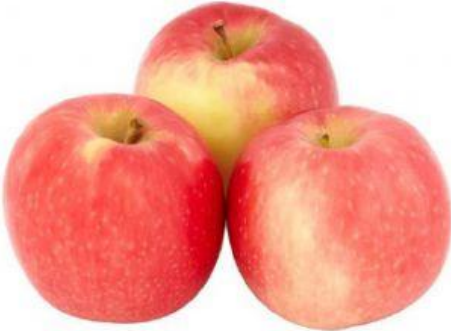
How many apples are falling off the tree? Put an X on it.

Some fruit have soft skin that may break open when it hits the ground. Apples, pears and peaches are examples of soft skinned fruit. Coconuts and nuts are examples of food that have hard and round outer shells. These foods may roll away when they fall off the parent plant.

Can you list 1 different soft skinned fruit not mentioned above that may break open when it hits the ground?

Seeds from fruit and nuts spread when they fall off plants. Fruit with soft skin that fall to ground may break open and scatter their seeds on the ground. Fruit with a hard-outer shell, may roll away from the parent plant. Their seeds spread because of this.

Water

There are many different kinds of plants that grow beside water. When light weight seeds fall in the water, the water carries them to a new place where they can grow. Two types of trees that grow beside water are willow trees and a birch trees. The seeds on Willow and Birch trees are very small and light. This makes them easy to float on water.

Two types of plants that grow beside water are the Yellow flag flower, and the Water Mint flower. Water carries their seeds to a new place where they can grow. The seeds these plants are very small and light. This makes them easy to float on water. Can you see the water near these plants?
