Emma-----so shocked when she heard of the plane crash.



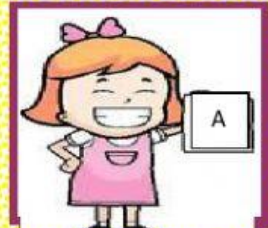
Alex -----scared at all when he tried bungee jumping.
