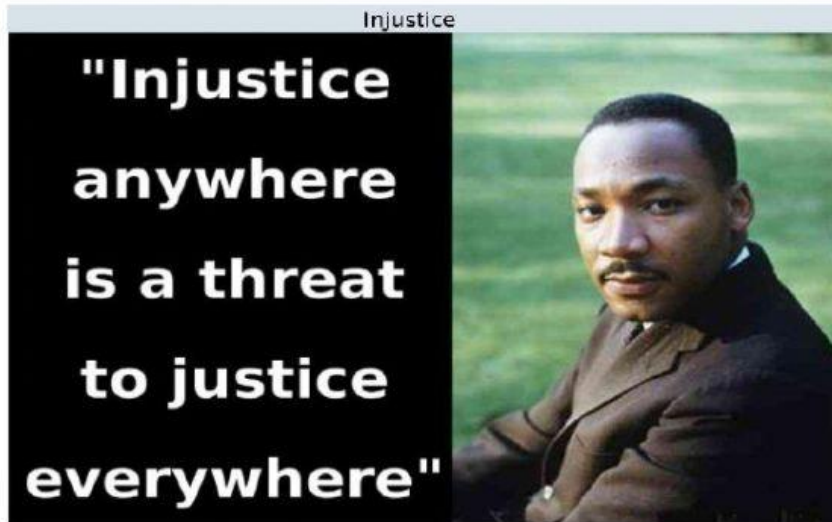


# Martin Luther King Jr / Past Simple
