#### Activity 4 Imagine and draw

What would you like to build? Imagine exactly how it would look, then make some sketches.

- 1 Think of a theme for your sculpture, and a good way to symbolise it. For example, the theme of Unity could be shown by many people gathered around a drum, singing. You can think big: maybe your public art can be a stadium or a play park. It can hang in a tree, or even float in the sky. Just think about how you would build it! How would you construct a model of one of these sculptures in card and paper?
- 2 Make some drawings. For inspiration, look at examples of technical drawings by **architects** and designers. Rough sketches are important in thinking up ideas. Combine ideas, move things around and draw them again. You should have 5 to 10 of these small sketches. Think about what your finished artwork will look like from behind. Walk around it in your mind.
- 3 Draw your planned artwork to **scale**. Show the size, and the things around it in proportion. Include people or buildings to show the scale. Give measurements. Go back to the perspective exercise to help draw your planned sculpture in its place.
- 4 Explain what materials you would use for this work. Label them.
- 5 Estimate a budget.
