- A past tense verb shows an action that has already happened.
- To form the past tense of regular verbs, add -ed to the plain verb.
For example : wash - washed brush - brushed walk - walked
- Verbs that show past tense in different ways are called irregular verbs.
For example : is, am - was are - were get - got
