## DISCUSSION TEXT

Discussion text bisa diartikan sebagai teks yang berisi pembahasan akan suatu hal dan memuat ide atau opini yang berbeda atau dari sudut pandang yang berbeda. Jadi, discussion text tidak serta merta merupakan pendapat penulis, namun menengahi suatu permasalahan dengan menyajikan argumen pro dan kontra.

### Generic structure Issue

Di bagian ini, penulis memperkenalkan isu yang dibahas dalam tulisannya. Arguments pro and contra Bagian ini memuat argumen pro (yang mendukung) dan kontra (yang menentang) atas pernyataan atau isu yang dibahas. Argumen ini bukan dari pendapat penulis melainkan entah dari beberapa pihak atau ahli yang mempunyai opini dari isu tersebut. Selain itu, pada setiap argumen penulis harus menuliskan ide pokok dan uraiannya.

### Recommendation or conclusion

Bagian terakhir ialah pendapat penulis akan isu yang dibahas. Penulis bisa mengambil satu poin dari argumen yang diberikan dan memberikan pernyataannya atau rekomendasinya.

ciri kebahasaan dari teks diskusi ialah:

1. Terdiri dari beberapa tenses. Umumnya dalam teks seperti ini kita menggunakan simple present tense, namun dalam beberapa kalimat yang mendukung pernyataan kita bisa menggunakan tenses lain.
2. Menggunakan general nouns, seperti governments, students, dan lain-lain
3. Menggunakan active voice atau kalimat aktif.
4. Menggunakan adjectives atau kata sifat.
5. Menggunakan conjunctions, seperti furthermore, as well as this, dan lain-lain.
6. Menggunakan contrastives, seperti conversely, on the other hand, dan lain-lain.
7. Menggunakan bahasa yang persuasif, deskriptif, dan judgmental.
8. Menggunakan imperative.

***Nuclear power is generated by using uranium, which is a metal mined in various parts of the world. The first large-scale nuclear power station was opened at Calder Hall in Cumbria, England, in 1956.***

Some military ships and submarines have nuclear power plant for engines. Nuclear power produces around 11% of the world's energy needed, and produces huge amounts of energy. It causes no pollution as you'd get when burning fossil fuels.

The advantages of nuclear is as follows:

- (1) It costs about the same as coal, so it's not expensive to make.
- (2) It doesn't produce smoke or carbon dioxide, so it doesn't contribute to the greenhouse effect.
- (3) It produces huge amounts of energy from small amount uranium.
- (4) It produces small amounts of waste.
- (5) It is reliable.

On the other hand, nuclear power is very, very dangerous. It must be sealed up and buried for many years to allow the radioactivity to die away. Furthermore, although it is reliable, a lot of money has to be spent on safety because if it does go wrong, a nuclear accident can be a major disaster.

People are increasingly concerned about this. In the 1990's nuclear power was the fastest growing source of power in many parts of the world. In 2005, it was the 2nd slowest-growing.
