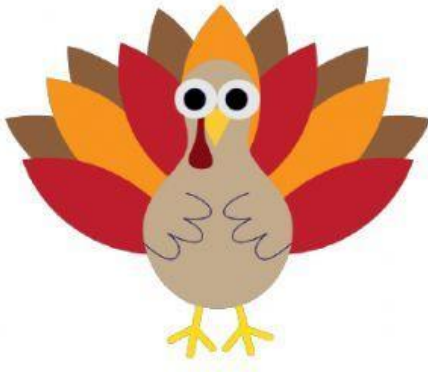


A. Read the following passage and do the activities that follow.
