Objective: Students will be able to sort verb+ing according to the rule
Students will be able to properly use correct form of verb(ing form) in the context.
Students will be able to write verb with correct spelling based on the rule they have learnt.

RULE 1 - Regular Verbs

Most of the verbs are regular. We just need to add "ing" at the end.

Example - read - reading, walk - walking, jump-jumping, fish - fishing

RULE 2 - Magical 'E'

If a word ends in magic e, you need to drop the "e" before adding "ing".

Example - take - taking, bake - baking, bite - biting, skate - skating

RULE 3 - Ending CVC words

When a word with one syllable ends in CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant), then you need to double the last consonant before adding "ing". But fix - fixing, mix-mixing Example - stop - stopping, mop - mopping, skip - Skipping, run - running
