2. Giving advice: SHOULD / SHOULDN'T

One of the words used to give advice is **SHOULD** or **SHOULDN'T** (in the negative form). This modal verb is invariable, it means it never change its form. It is followed by a verb.

(Una de las palabras usadas para dar consejo es **SHOULD** (deberías) o **SHOULDN'T** (no deberías, en la forma negativa). Este verbo modal es invariable, es decir, nunca cambia su forma. Es seguido por un verbo que le da sentido a la oración, por ejemplo: "You should study".)

STRUCTURE →

	subject	should	not	main verb
+	He	should		work.
-	You	should	not	go.

→ Él debería trabajar.

→ Tú no deberías ir.

3. Adverbs of Frequency

ADVERBS OF DEFINITE FREQUENCY

We learnt about adverbs of frequency (*always, sometimes, never, etc.*) but now we are going to learn some other expressions to be more specific about the frequency. These are also known as **Adverbs of DEFINITE frequency** because **the exact frequency is specified.**

Aprendimos sobre los adverbios de frecuencia (*siempre, a veces, nunca, etc.*) pero ahora vamos a aprender otras expresiones para ser más específicos sobre la frecuencia. Estas expresiones también se conocen como "adverbios de frecuencia definida" ya que la frecuencia es especificada.

Examples:

- once → una vez
- once a month → una vez al mes
- twice* a year → dos veces* al año
- every day → cada día
- three times a month → tres veces al mes
- daily → diariamente
- weekly → semanalmente
- monthly → mensualmente
- annually / yearly → anualmente

LOOK!

We usually use them at the end of a sentence.

(Usualmente los usamos al final de la oración)

Look at the following structures to create expressions:
