## SAFE SPLASHING

1. Do not play or run around the pool. The **surface** is wet and you might slip and fall.



2. You shouldn't eat before swimming. It can lead to stomach **cramps** or you might drown.

3. Make sure you know where the lifeguards are and call them if you get **into trouble**. They are there to save lives so always do what they say.

4. Always pay attention to the **NO DIVING** signs around the pool. **ONLY** dive in designated areas.

5. Dive-bombing can be a lot of fun, but it can also put other swimmers in danger. **NEVER** jump in like this.

6. All pools have rules displayed on signs around the pool. Always read them before you start swimming. They are there to keep you safe. Enjoy your swim!
