We use *would* and *wouldn't* + base form to talk about imaginary or hypothetical situations.

Where **would** you **go** on your perfect vacation?

I'd rent a house next to the beach.

I wouldn't stay in a hotel.

Affirmative

I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	'd / would	buy	a new car.
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Negative

I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	wouldn't	live	in a city.
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Questions

Would	I / you / he / she / it / we / you / they	tell	anyone?
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Short answers

Yes,	I / you / he / she / it / we / you / they	would.
No,		wouldn't.
