We use **would** and **wouldn't** + base form to talk about imaginary or hypothetical situations.

Where would you go on your perfect vacation?

I'd rent a house next to the beach.

I wouldn't stay in a hotel.

Affirmative

I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	'd / would	buy	a new car.
--	------------	-----	------------

Negative

I / You / He / She / It / We / You / They	wouldn't	live	in a city.
--	----------	------	------------

Questions

Would	I / you / he / she / it / we / you / they	tell	anyone?
-------	--	------	---------

Short answers

Yes,	I / you / he / she / it /	would.
No,	we / you / they	wouldn't.
