

**Complete the advice about the conversation phase by choosing *Do* or *Don't* to start each sentence.**

1. .... answer the question you are asked!
2. .... just answer yes or no when the examiner asks you a question!
3. .... start an answer with "Let me think..." or "Let's see..." if you need extra time to think.
4. .... pause for too long before answering.
5. .... be prepared to give reasons for, or more details about, something you say.
6. .... remember that it is alright to talk about something ordinary, not having done something really exciting isn't an excuse for not talking!
7. .... ask the examiner at least 1 question. You could ask about the subject she/he has just asked YOU about.
8. .... show interest in and/or comment on the answer the examiner gives to your questions, with expressions such as, "That sounds nice", "That sounds like fun", "How nice", "Really?".
