

## MIXED CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

### Remember!

If I had slept all night, I wouldn't be tired now.  If + Past Perfect (type 3) + Conditional Simple (type 2)

If I were you, I would have talked to him.  If + Past Simple (type 2) + Conditional Perfect (type 3)
