

MIXED CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

Remember!

If I had slept all night, I wouldn't be tired now. ➡ If + Past Perfect (type 3) + Conditional Simple (type 2)

If I were you, I would have talked to him. ➡ If + Past Simple (type 2) + Conditional Perfect (type 3)

Read these sentences carefully. Rewrite them so that they have the same meaning. Use mixed conditional sentences and the words in capitals given.

- 2) We don't have access to the company's network. We couldn't enter the data yesterday. HAVE
- 3) I spent too much on holiday. I don't have any money now. WOULD
- 4) The repairman didn't repair my laptop yesterday so I can't use it now. COULD
- 5) I think you should have bought the other dress. WERE
- 6) It's really hot today so I refused Mike to go to the cinema. WOULDN'T
- 7) We cancelled out holiday and now we aren't having fun in the beach. HADN'T
- 8) She can't speak Russian fluently so the meeting didn't take place. COULD
