 He/She/It IS NOT / ISN'T

 ? AM I ?

HAVE GOT

Tener

+ I/You/We/They HAVE GOT
 He/She/It HAS GOT

 I/You/We/They HAVEN'T GOT
 (have not got)
 - He/She/It HASN'T GOT
 (has not got)

 ? HAVE I/ You/We/They GOT?
 HAS He/She/It GOT?

*We don't use HAVE GOT with age and feelings: I am 11 years old / He is tired
 No usamos "have got" para la edad o los sentimientos (ver ejemplos)
