THERE WAS

Significa **había**. Para singular y pasado.

There was a cat/ **Había** un gato
There wasn't a dog/ **No había** un perro

THERE WERE

Significa **había**. Para plural y pasado.

There were two cats/ **Había** dos gatos
There weren't three dogs/ **No había** tres perros

Affirmative:

There was a cinema.

There was some milk.

There were some books.

Negative:

There wasn't a cinema.

There wasn't any milk.

There weren't any books.
