1. There should be continuous engagement over the course of the trimester regarding the reading program. Students must develop a love for reading.
2. Follow up will take place in every single class calling upon random students to ensure the weekly reading targets are being met.
3. Students must check and review the feedback signaled by the teacher so that they can learn and improve.
4. Book must be in English. It must be of at least 200 pages long.
5. It must be a STORY with a several characters, a setting, beginning, middle, and end.
6. NO Spanish is allowed in English book reports.
7. ANY suspicion of plagiarism will be reported to Dirección Académica and follow up with the family and student must take place in a meeting. Work must be redone and this act comes with disciplinary consequences.
8. Work which is not to the correct quality standard will be rejected and the student must redo it.
9. Sentence structure must be respected along with capitalization and punctuation.
10. Complete sentences must be developed.
11. No one-word answers are permitted.
No lists of names or items are permitted.
12. To finish reading your book and to hand in your book report on time you must read AT LEAST 30 pages per week.
