- PRESENT SIMPLE SENTENCES: NEGATIVE.

(DON'T or DOESN'T + INFINITIVE)

They(not play) in the park.

He.....(not go) to school.

I.....(not eat) too much fruit these days.

She.....(not visit) her relatives.

We.....(see) our friends very often.

- PRESENT SIMPLE SENTENCES. INTERROGATIVE.

(DO/ DOES (subject) + INFINITIVE)

..... you.....(drink) coffee for breakfast?

.....she.....(do) her homework alone?

.....they.....(study) English at school?

..... Ana and Paul.....(walk) the dog in the afternoon?

.....Tom..... (play) computer games?
