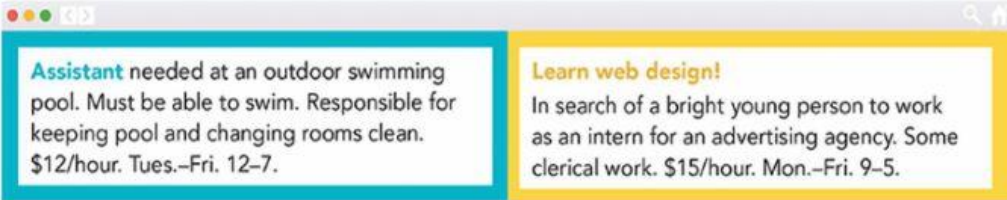
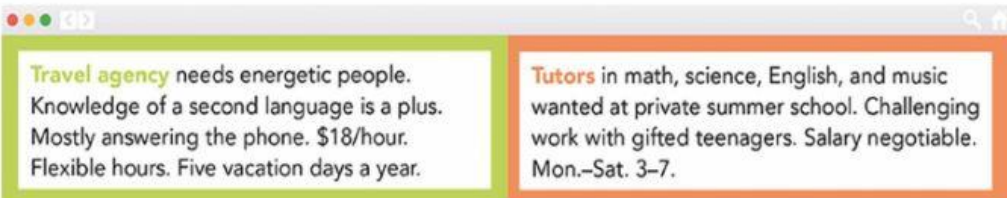


Read the job advertisements. Then complete the comparisons with the words in parentheses.
