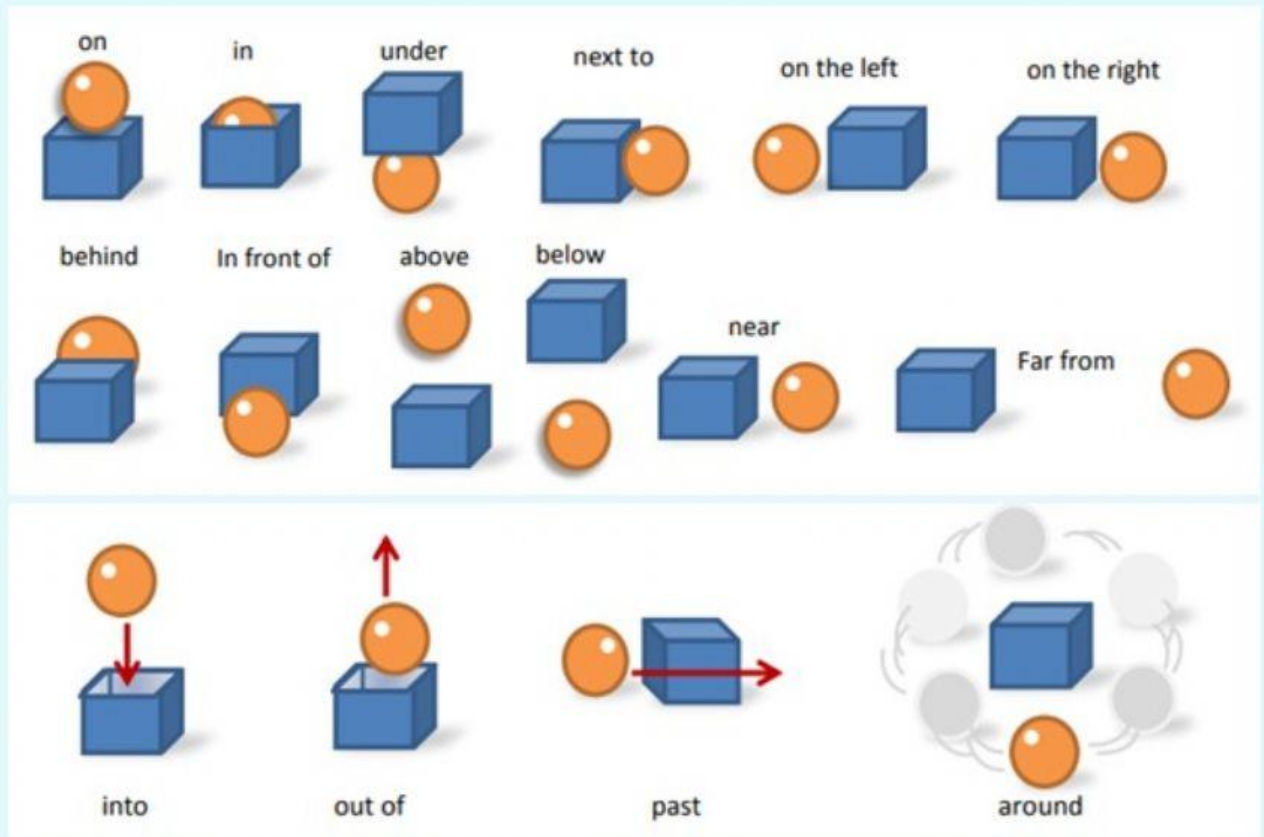


## Prepositions of Place
