<p>Most common type of questions. The normal rules that you learn about making questions, such word order and the auxiliary verb. We want to know about the <u>object</u>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What do you like? <u>I like ice cream</u> • What did you have for breakfast? <u>I had pancakes</u>. • Where did you go yesterday? <u>I went to the mall</u>. • Where is the car? <u>The car is in the garage</u>. 	<p>We don't need to use auxiliary verbs. We generally make subject questions using 'who' or 'what'. We want to know about the <u>subject</u>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Who likes ice cream? <u>Sandra</u> likes ice cream. • Who had pancakes for breakfast? <u>Alex</u> had pancakes for breakfast. • Who went with you? <u>My best friend</u> went with me. • What is in the garage? <u>The car</u> is in the garage.
