Many believe that 'Avial' was invented by the mighty Bhima – one of the five Pandava brothers from the Mahabharata epic. Avial is basically a healthy mix of various vegetables in a coconut and yogurt sauce with a finishing of coconut oil and curry leaves. In the recipe, the vegetables that are added are not the usual mixed veggie combination like cauliflower, carrot, peas, beans. The veggies are unique and largely seasonal depending on what is available. Like - Drumsticks (sahjan ki phalli, moringa pods) , Carrots, Madras cucumber – also known as Mangalore cucumber or field marrow ,Raw plantain – Unripe bananas, Pumpkin (kaddu), Ash gourd (petha), Green beans – any variety can be used & Tendli (tindora, ivy gourd) To make Avial 1. Firstly rinse all the veggies very well with water and then drain all the water. 2. Then peel and chop them in medium to long sticks or batons. 3. Whip 1 cup fresh curd (yogurt) with a wired whisk and keep aside. 4. Make Coconut paste 5. Cook vegetables 6. Add coconut paste. 7. Add whisked curd and mix well. 8 Serve hot
