

Grammar and Structure -ing Spelling Rules

- when a verb **ends in "e"**, drop the "e" and add "-ing". For example:
take = taking / drive = driving / make = making
- **CVC; 1consonant+ 1vowel + 1consonant**, double the final consonant and add "-ing". For example: hit = hitting / run = running / put = putting
 ** shop = shopping / chop = chopping
 ** swim = swimming / spin = spinning
- when a verb **ends in "ie"**, drop the "ie" and add "-ying". For example: die = dying / tie = tying / lie = lying
- add "-ing" to the verb.
