





What is a computer?

A computer is a programmable electronic device that accepts raw data as input and processes it with a set of instructions (a program) to produce the result as output.






















Central Processing Unit (CPU)



Controlling the computer and processing data according to the given instructions are done by the Central Processing Unit.







Communication Devices

The devices which are used to exchange the processed data and information are called communication devices.











Main Memory

The device which is used to store data, information and instructions temporarily is identified as the main memory or the primary memory. It is also called the Random Access Total Indian Memory (RAM).


