But in 1992, a committee member of the Squash Racket Association of Penang noticed David's talent in squash. David was then led to compete in junior championships. In the same year, David won her first national level victory at the Milo-Dunlop Sport National Junior Interstate Championship.

Her greatest achievements are winning the World Squash Championships a record of eight times. She retired from playing squash in June 2019.
