

SUPERLATIVE ADJECTIVES

Always add 'The'
before the adjectives

How to form Superlative adjectives?

One syllable	-EST Example: tallest, fastest
One syllable Ending in -E	-ST Example: nicest, strangest
One syllable Consonant + Short Vowel + Consonant	Double the consonant and add EST Example: biggest, hottest
Two syllable Ending in -Y	Remove the -Y and add - IEST Example: happiest, craziest
Two or More Syllables	Most+ Example: most beautiful, most handsome
Common exceptions	Good – best Bad – worst
