## Possessive Pronouns



A Possessive Pronoun replaces a **possessive adjective + noun** to avoid repeating information that is already clear.

- This **book** is **my book**, not **your book**. (Sounds repetitive)
- This **book** is **mine**, not **yours**. (Sounds more natural)

### POSSESSIVE ADJECTIVE

MY	My <b>shirt</b> is green.
YOUR	Your <b>book</b> is new.
HIS	His <b>pillow</b> is soft.
HER	Her <b>dog</b> is small.
ITS	Its <b>bone</b> is old.
OUR	Our <b>bird</b> is noisy.
YOUR	Your <b>house</b> is big.
THEIR	Their <b>car</b> is slow.

### POSSESSIVE PRONOUN

MINE	The shirt is <b>mine</b> .
YOURS	The book is <b>yours</b> .
HIS	The pillow is <b>his</b> .
HERS	The dog is <b>hers</b> .
----- *	* We don't use <b>its</b> as a possessive pronoun.
OURS	The bird is <b>ours</b> .
YOURS	The house is <b>yours</b> .
THEIRS	The car is <b>theirs</b> .


