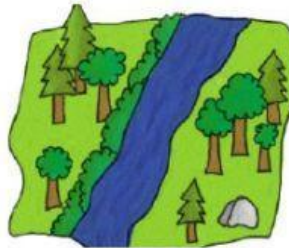


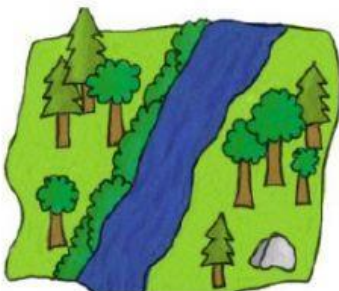
# Weathering and Erosion

Weathering The wind, water or ice break the rocks.	Erosion The wind, water or ice move the sediments.



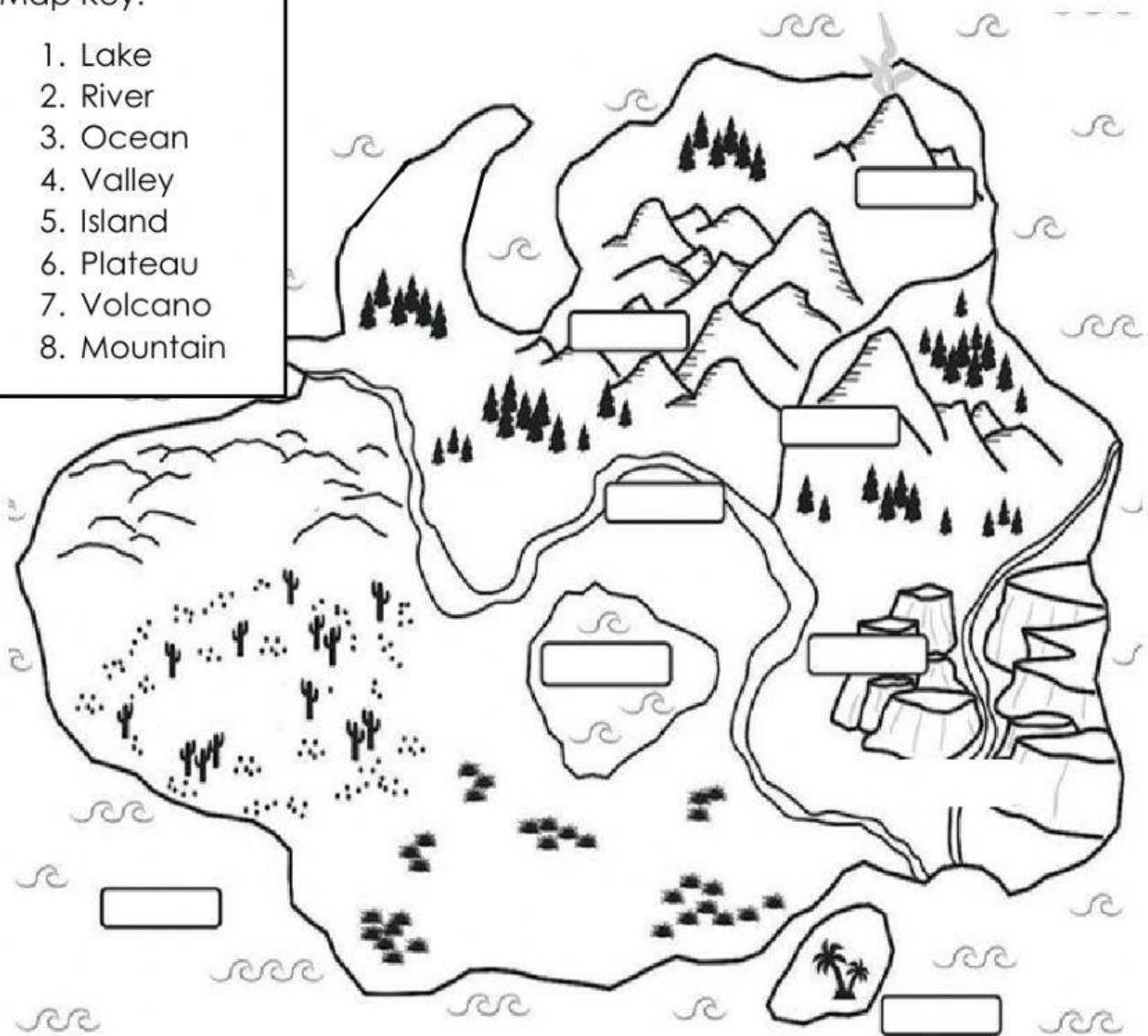
Write the name of the corresponding earth change below the pictures. There are examples of **weathering** and examples of **erosion**.

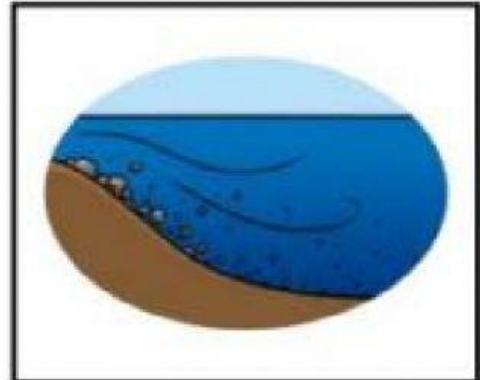

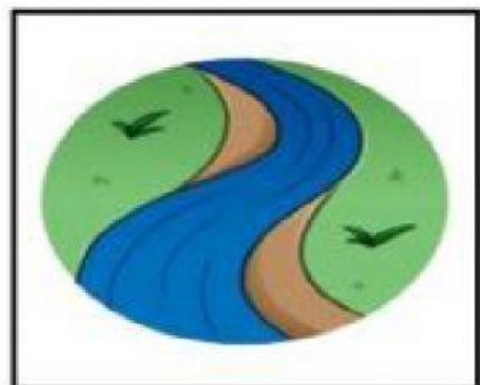
