How long - length or length of time;

How tall - height; How far - distance;

How fast - speed; How big - size;

How often - frequency;

How many - number; How much - amount

Pay attention: when the question contains the adjectives tall, high, long, wide, deep, we put the adjective in the answer.

Notice the word order:

How tall is Adam? Adam is 1.7 metres tall.
