### DIRECT SPEECH

DIANE SAID, "I AM HAPPY TODAY."

## REPORTED/INDIRECT SPEECH

DIANE SAID (THAT) SHE WAS HAPPY THAT DAY.

WHEN WE CHANGE DIRECT SPEECH TO REPORTED SPEECH, WE MUST OFTEN CHANGE THE TENSE.


EX. SHE SAID, " I AM TIRED." - DIRECT SPEECH
SHE SAID THAT SHE WAS TIRED. - REPORTED SPEECH

HE SAID, "I HAVE SEEN SNOW." - DIRECT
HE SAID THAT HE HAD SEEN SNOW. - REPORTED
