1. Write the first month of the year in the top right hand corner of your test paper. (Use capital letters only when it is necessary).
2. Write the answer to the following multiplication problem directly underneath the month on your test paper (All in small letters): $6 \times 5 = ?$
3. Write the name of the month that begins with the letter "D" in the top left hand corner of your test paper.
4. Add 15 to the answer you got in #2, and write this new total directly underneath your answer for #3.
5. Write the name of the first president of the United States on the lower right hand corner of your test paper. If you don't know who this is, you can find the answer in other part of this paper.
6. Take the number of dwarfs in the Snow White story and add it to the number of bears in the Goldilocks story. Divide by 2. Write this total in the next square.
7. How many colors does the rainbow have? Double that number. Add 20. Add 6. Subtract 17. Subtract 9. Divide by 2. Write this number on your test paper directly underneath your answer to # 8.
8. The name of the first president of the United States is George Washington. He was president from 1789 until 1797. Add the two dates together and write the answer on the lower left hand corner of your test paper.
