


¿Qué es un párrafo?

1. **Topic sentence:** Oración que resume lo que se dirá en el párrafo.
2. **Supporting sentences:** Oraciones que dan más información o detalles sobre el tema.
3. **Concluding sentence:** Oración que brinda una conclusión o cierre al párrafo.

Recuerda que un párrafo no debe ser muy largo y debe contener oraciones sobre un mismo tema.
