_____ : Coming from Greek, it means people.

_____ : Coming from Latin, it means people.

_____ : It derives from the Latin expression meaning "the affairs of the public" and is used to designate a form of government in which a State is ruled by representatives of the citizen body and organized into independent branches.

_____ : It derives from a Greek expression meaning "the power of the people" and is used to refer to a form of government in which the participation of the citizens is expected either in a direct or an indirect way.

_____ : Coming from Greek, it means power or government.

_____ : Coming from Latin, it means thing or affair.

_____ : It's a political system based upon the rule of a single person who is the head of the State and who usually holds a hereditary position.

_____ : It's a political program that, in its most democratic form, should seek to defend the interests of ordinary citizens. However, currently it can be associated with an authoritarian form of politics around a charismatic leader who claims to embody the will of the people in order to consolidate her/his own power.

_____ : It's a system of government where the State seeks to control every aspect of civil life and society.

_____ : It's a form of government in which the supreme power is concentrated in a person whose decisions and actions are not subjected to either legal restraints or democratic mechanisms.

_____ : It's a form of government in which absolute power is concentrated either in one person or a small group.
