Traditional Samoan Houses

Overall design

- house: round or 1
- no walls
- 2 : to shelter occupants from wind and rain
- floor: 3 to control temperature

Roof

- dome-shaped and thatched using 4 leaves
- 5 sides prevent dampness
- high top permits 6 loss

Supporting posts

- made using wood from the 7 around the village
- used to show 8 of chiefs and speakers at meetings
- attached using rope made by the 9 in the village
- rope pulled tightly to form a 10 around beams and posts
