Read On

This module is more on art activities, application or drawing using different kinds of drawing tools and materials. You will draw yourself, your family, different plants, and leaves using different drawing tools.

You can use pencil, crayon, ink, chalk, charcoal, pens, and others. But for kids like you, pencil is the best tool to use on your drawing. You can color your works using crayon, watercolor, petals or leaves of the plant. Yes, you read it right! You can use parts of plants to apply color. Now, can you still remember the parts of a plant? _____ Will you write 3 parts of a plant?

Different drawing tools:

1. **Pencils** - an instrument for writing or drawing.



2. **Sketch pad** - a pad or book of drawing paper for sketching.



3. **Eraser** - an object of soft rubber or plastic used to rub out something written.



4. **Pencil sharpener** - a device or tool for making something sharper.



5. **Coloring Materials** : crayon, colored pencils and pens, water color and charcoal are examples of coloring materials.



Crayon is a stick of colored wax



Colored pencils are constructed of a narrow, pigmented core encased in a wooden cylindrical case.



Colored pens are liquid ink pen, each of different colors, having a writing point and a tubular receiving body as an ink reservoir.



Watercolor is a type of paint that can be mixed with water to create color on paper.

Plants are different from one another. Observe their sizes, shapes, lines, color, and texture. It makes them unique.

I will give you time to look for 3 plants and observe them. Observe their sizes, shapes, colors, lines of the leaves and their flowers.

Now after observing the plants at home or in your garden, what can you say about their characteristics? How can you show your love for them?

As a young Ignacian Marian learner, how can you help in the conservation of our plants so that they will not die easily?

Read and think about what is written in 1 Corinthians 16: 14 *Let all that you do be done in love.* How will you connect this to making of your artwork?

Time to show your creativity!


- A. Draw a flower that you have observed a while ago. Use petals to color your drawing.



- B. Draw 3 different kinds of leaves with their shape and lines. Use leaves to color your drawing.



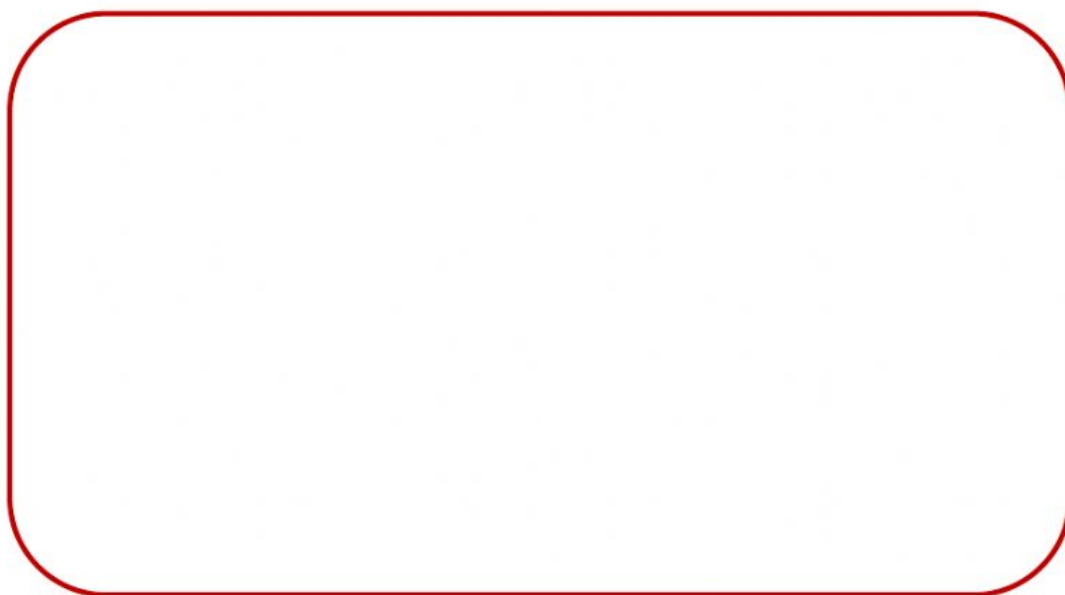
- C. Draw the 3 plants that you observed a while ago. Use your crayons to color your drawings.
