- 1. A complex sentence has an independent clause and a dependent clause.
- An independent clause can stand alone as a sentence. A dependent clause cannot stand alone.
- 3. A complex sentence can also be joined by relative pronouns who, which, whose and whom.
- 4. 'Who' and 'whom' are used for people.
- 'Which' is used for animals and things. 'Whose' is used when something belongs to a person. Examples:
 - That is the girl who won the cupcake decorating competition.
 - My mother has a handbag which is made of leather.
 - That is the boy whose mother is a famous author.
