Get It Right

1. A complex sentence has an **independent clause** and a **dependent clause**.
2. An independent clause can **stand alone as a sentence**. A dependent clause cannot stand alone.
3. A complex sentence can also be joined by **relative pronouns** – *who*, *which*, *whose* and *whom*.
4. 'Who' and 'whom' are used for **people**.
5. 'Which' is used for **animals and things**. 'Whose' is used when **something belongs to a person**.

Examples:

- That is the girl **who** won the cupcake decorating competition.
- My mother has a handbag **which** is made of leather.
- That is the boy **whose** mother is a famous author.
