Το δικό μου (σου, του) μολύβι.	Τα δικά μας (σας, τους) μολύβιο
Το μολύβι μου (σου, του).	Τα μολύβια μας (σας, τους).



POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS

A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that is used to indicate possession or ownership.

- . This pen is my pen, not your pen.
- . This pen is mine, not yours.

MINE

. This is my laptop. It's mine.

YOURS

. These glasses are mine, not yours.

HIS

This is my brother 's book. It's his.

HERS

He offered to swap his camera for hers.

OURS

• I'll show you to your room. Ours is next door.

YOURS

The house is yours.

THEIRS

The ship is theirs.
