### AFFIRMATIVE

Subject	Verb -ed	Complements	Past time expression
Mary	visited	London	a year ago

### NEGATIVE

Subject	Didn't	Verb (infinitive)	Complements	Past time expressions
Mary	didn't	visit	London	a year ago



### INTERROGATIVE

Did	Subject	Verb (infinitive)	Complements	Past time expressions
Did	Mary	visit	London	a year ago?



As you can see, the **verb** in negative and interrogative sentences goes into **infinitive**.  
**Did** or **didn't** let us know that we are in the past.
