We use **prepositions of time** to talk about: a date on the calendar, one of the days of the week, or the actual time when an action/event takes place/happens.

IN	We use IN for: months, years, seasons, centuries, long periods	in July, in 2020, in winter, in the next century, in the past/future.
ON	We use ON for: days and dates	on Saturday, on 11 th July, on my birthday
AT	We use AT for: a precise time	at 7 o'clock, at noon, at dinner time, at sunrise, at the moment,
