



Linking Verbs

Linking verbs do not show action. Instead, they link the subject with a word or words in the predicate that tell something about the subject. **Linking verbs** are forms of the verb **be** and verbs such as **seem** and **become**.

Verbs that show actions are called **action verbs**.

Examples

Action verb: The skier **ran** down the mountain.

Linking verb: I **am** a shopaholic.

appear – feel – grow – look – prove –
remain – smell – sound – taste – turn

If the above words can be substituted with am, are, is the words are linking verbs. Other than that they are action verb.
