# ADD '-S' or '-ES' or '-IES'



**Present Simple + Third Person Singular:** With most verbs, simply add '-s'. For example: "She works in an office."

- However, you should add '-es' to the following kinds of verbs:

<b>He</b> <b>She</b> <b>It</b>	wa <u>tch</u> es TV. tea <u>ch</u> es English.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• verbs ending in '-tch' or '-ch'</li> </ul>
	wa <u>sh</u> es his/her/its clothes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• verbs ending in '-sh'</li> </ul>
	mi <u>ss</u> es his/her/its friend.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• verbs ending in '-ss'</li> </ul>
	g <u>o</u> es to school. d <u>o</u> es exercise.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• verbs ending in '-o'</li> </ul>
	fi <u>x</u> es broken bicycles.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• verbs ending in '-x'</li> </ul>
	stud <u>i</u> es English.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• verbs ending in a consonant + '-y' change to 'i' before adding '-es'</li> </ul>
	pl <u>a</u> ys tennis.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Note that verbs ending in a vowel + '-y' just add '-s' (vowels: a,e,i,o,u)</li> </ul>
