

Past simple

We use the **past simple** to talk about things we did in the past.

To make the past simple, we add **-ed** to most verbs.

I/You/He/She/It/We/They **cleaned**.

We add **-d** to verbs that end in **-e**.

like → **liked** **dance** → **danced**
