Related Vocabulary

Attachment: any type of file sent along with an email message

CC: stands for Carbon copy. Put email address(es) here if you plan to send a copy to other recipients in addition to those listed in the 'To' field. This is used if you don't mind that recipients seeing who else is getting a copy, because the list of recipients is included in the header message.

BCC: similar to Cc, Blind Carbon Copy sends a copy of a message for the information of a large number of people. It is used if you are sending someone a copy of an email, and you don't want the other recipients to see that it was also sent to this email address because the message doesn't include that information in its header fields.
Bcc recipients can see those listed in the To and Cc list
