"Dennis the Menace" is a comic strip originally created, written and illustrated by Hank

Dennis Mitchell (be) a 5 1/2 year old boy. He (live) with his parents, Henry and Alice Mitchell, in Wichita, Kansas, in the USA. He (not have got) any brothers or sisters, but he (have) a dog, Ruff, who is his best friend. Dennis (wear, usually)a blue-and-black striped shirt, tennis shoes and red overalls.

1 Dennis is young, full of energy, enthusiastic and very curious. He (say, always) what he thinks, which people (hate, often)! He (try, usually) to help others but he also (play, sometimes) pranks on people. He (get, always) in trouble and (bring) chaos wherever he (go), that's why his nickname is "the Menace".

The Wilsons, George and Martha, (be) his neighbours. They (live) next door to the Mitchell family. Martha (adore) Dennis, but Mr. Wilson (not like him - or so he (say) - as he (be, usually) the victim of Dennis's mischief: he (get, often) hurt, or his things (get) destroyed. The boy (love) him, though, and (think) Mr. Wilson is his best adult friend.

- What is going on, Ruff? What is Dennis doing right now?

He (try) to put a pill in the old man's mouth but Mr. Wilson (not open) it. Dennis (have) an idea. What (he/do)? He (climb) on Mr. Wilson. And he (take) a slingshot out of his pocket. He (aim) and... he (shoot) a pill right into Mr. Wilson's throat! Mr. Wilson (scream) and Dennis (run) away back to his house and me!


Dennis (prank) on people but this time, his mother (a trick on him, with the carrots in the cookie jar!)
