

# First Conditional

## What is the First Conditional?

First conditional is used to talk about actions/events in the future which are likely to happen or have a real possibility of happening. For example: If it rains tomorrow, I'll stay at home.

if clause + main clause

Form

If + (present simple) + will + base verb

## Exercises

### Remember!
