The word ‘Ramadan’ comes from the Arabic root “arramad” which means **scorching heat** or dryness

In Islamic **lunar** calendar, Ramadan **takes place** in the ninth month.

The Muslims **refrain** themselves **from** eating and drinking between dawn and sunset and this is called “**fasting**”

During the most **sacred** month Ramadan, Muslims abstain from pleasure and try to become closer to God.

Also, it is a time for families to **gather** and celebrate

Ramadan is a time for **sacrifice** and **renunciation**.

Also, the sacred month is symbol of unity for Muslims who fast **simultaneously**.
