

### Reading activity "Chilean human rights violations"

Read about people sharing their opinions about the Chilean human rights violations and how people should be treated.

In my opinion, the most violated human right in Chile is the right to education. The Chilean students have fought continuously to get a free and good quality education, but the government hasn't given a proper solution yet. Instead, they have created laws that continue segregating students from different realities which shows that are in favor of those students who have a higher social status. The government should provide an equal and high-quality education for everyone and not just for those who can afford it. The government shouldn't think that people cannot realize what they do and what they don't do.

From my perspective, the most violated human right in Chile is the right to own a property. In Chile, all of us have the right to get a property or a house, but is the cost? The UF price is so high that we have to pay a lot of money just to get a reasonable house size. If you do not have a proper amount of money in your bank account, then you cannot buy a house, because you're too poor to have one. So, the government should give the possibility to everyone to buy a big house by using credit at an affordable amount of money. However, the government shouldn't allow people to buy more than two houses and in that way, everyone should be able to get one.

From my point of view, the right to marriage and family is the most violated one. It is because we are still living in a country where people cannot express their feelings and preferences freely. We are still under a conservative government that does not accept new relationship status. The government should be more open-minded and accept same gender families to adopt orphan children. The government shouldn't accept everyone to adopt, it is a rigorous situation, but not to reject it because of their sexual preference.
