### France prohibits smartphones at schools



France voted to ban smartphones \_\_\_\_\_ (1) personal tablets from schools. The government prohibit students aged between 3 \_\_\_\_\_ (2) 15 from even bringing their technological devices to school. The prohibition is part of a
